The Holocaust and War Victims Tracing Center is a national clearinghouse for persons seeking the fates of loved ones missing since the Holocaust and its aftermath, including those seeking documentation of forced labor, forced evacuation from former Soviet territories, internment in concentration camps, or deportation required for reparations. The Center assists American residents and conducts searches on behalf of individuals living outside the U.S. for relatives believed to have emigrated to the U.S.

The mission of the Holocaust and War Victims Tracing Center is to help alleviate the emotional, spiritual, and psychological distress of survivors and their families by providing them with humanitarian tracing, reunification, and certification services, and information about missing loved ones.
